- ➤ In order to participate in the meetings, please return the enclosed registration form, duly completed, to the UNESCO Secretariat **preferably before 5 September 2017**. - ➤ Participants are requested to sign in at the entrance on Tuesday, 12 September from 9.30 a.m. to 10 a.m. in order to obtain a badge for the meetings. Because of security measures in force at UNESCO, all participants will be required to pass through the security check at the entrance before proceeding to Room XI. All participants must also wear their badges throughout the meetings to facilitate identification.
- ➤ Participants are also requested to register at the Conference Desk in front of Room XI prior to the meetings. Upon registration, participants will receive a complete set of documents and any other relevant documentation. A welcome coffee will also be provided during the morning of 12 September.

CURRENCY AND EXCHANGE

➤ The national currency is the Euro (€). In June 2017 one US dollar was equal to approximately 0.893 € (This rate is subject to fluctuation and may be modified without prior warning.)

CLIMATE AND CLOTHING

➤ The average minimum/maximum temperatures in Paris in September range from 8° to 15°C (46°/59°F). The weather can vary from sunny to cool, even chilly, nights. Formal attire is suggested for all official events.
